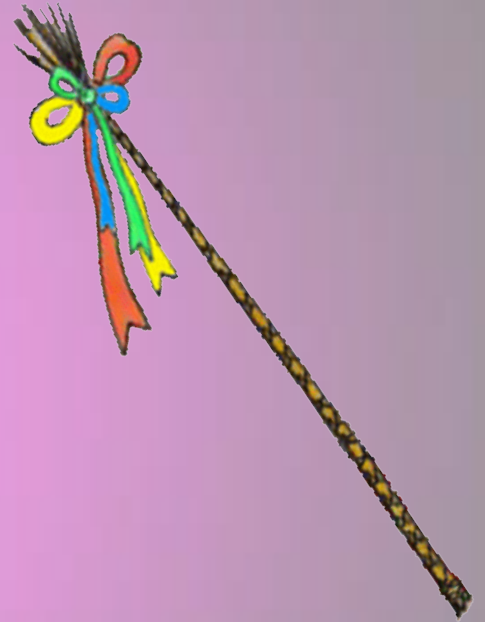

Willow cane – Pomlázka

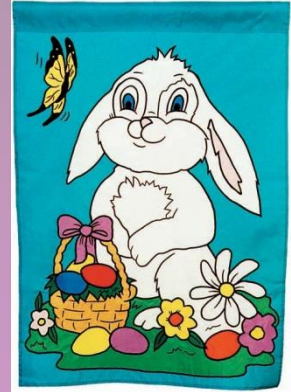


Easter Bunny – Velikonoční zajíček

Easter activities

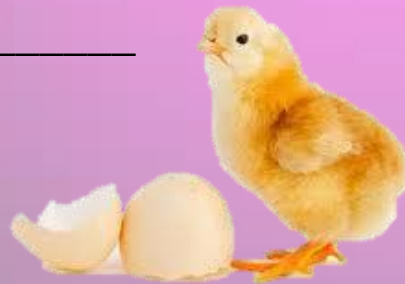
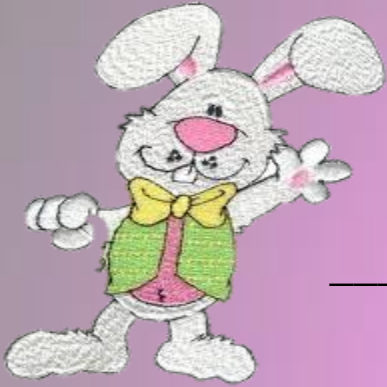
Boys prepare plaited willow canes.
